Approval of Minutes from November 3, 2011: MSP Nov. 3, 2011 Minutes

Treasurer's Report: John Weber

- This is a three month report from November, 2011 through January 2012.
- All lakes had paid for 2011 water testing by the November meeting.
- The board had approved up to \$2,200.00 to cover AIS shortfall. The money actually needed was \$1,922.66. The Treasurer's report shows a deficit due to copies made from Sept. 11 Aug. 12.
- Envelopes have been made with the COLA logo and are available.
- There is a need to know how many lakes use the GIS program available to COLA. The cost per year to have this service available through Ed Mutsch is \$250.00

- By going to emailing the newsletter COLA saved \$1500.00

 - i. **Training/lake trends/equipment pickup:** Will be Wednesday May 16, 2012 at 7:00 pm at the Hubbard County Courthouse. There will also be a little workshop on water trends in our lakes that have been tested by RMB labs for monitors to take back to their associations.

C. Government Liaison – State/LGU – Impact Political Action (C. Diessner):

- a. Summary of Board of Adjustment (BOA) actions:
 - i. Variances are granted by the BOA 76% of the time.
 - ii. 53% of all variances are granted when the BOA disagrees with Environmental Services Office (ESO) and COLA. .
 - iii. The BOA approved "after the fact" variances 74% of the time going against the advice of ESO and COLA.

- c. **Lawsuit:** Oral arguments before the Court of Appeals were held Feb. 1, 2012. The MN Center for Environmental Advocacy gave an Amicus Brief supporting COLA. The Court has 90 days in which to present its ruling which should be around April 30, 2012.
- d. **New Appointee on BOA:** Ken Grob has been appointed by Kathy Grell to the Board of Adjustment.
