- Boulder Faucet Snail
- Long Zebra Mussel



Where we are at: 2021

- Completed DNR Level 1 Online Training a week prior to Fishing
 Opener
 - 45 Level 1 Inspectors
- Inspector Mentor Day for new inspectors May 14th
- 29 accesses on 27 waterbodies covered on Fishing Opener
- 35 accesses on 33 waterbodies covered over Memorial Day Weekend

- Level 2 inspectors
 - 4 certified Level 2 Inspectors
