- DNR Level 1 In-person Training was held on April 23rd in Park Rapids
  - Currently 41 Level 1 Inspectors hired
- Level 2 Inspectors
  - 4 returning Level 2 Inspectors

# **Looking Ahead**

- Inspector Mentor Day for new inspectors Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>
- 31 accesses on 29 waterbodies scheduled to have an inspector on Fishing Opener
- 34 accesses on 32 waterbodies scheduled to have an inspector over
  Memorial Day Weekend

- 34 Boat Launches on 32 Lakes in Hubbard County
- 15,878 scheduled inspection hours
- Shifts scheduled heavily on weekends and Holidays
- Busiest accesses scheduled during weekdays too
