## Community Outreach

- Watercraft Inspection Program.
  - 42 Inspectors, including 5 Level 2 inspectors & 1 Lead inspector
  - Engaged watercraft users at 34 accesses.
- AIS prevention advertisements on KDKK, KXKK, KPRM.
  - Several new decontamination-specific adds.
- AIS billboard State Hwy 34 & County 4 intersection, East of Park Rapids (COLA partnership).
- Aqua Weed Sticks distributed to accesses county-wide
  - Promote hands-on public engagement with AIS prevention
- AIS prevention newspaper articles throughout the summer.
- Starry Trek Community volunteers sampling for SSW
  - 22 public accesses sampled at 20 different lakes
  - 10 volunteers
  - No new AIS found





## Inspection Summary

- Inspection season ran from May 13<sup>th</sup> Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>
  - Big Mantrap & Big Sand inspections extended through October
- 14,468 hours worked (as of October 17<sup>th</sup>)
  - 14,600 total scheduled.
- So far: 19,779 inspection surveys completed
  - Inspections are still ongoing
- 98.65% compliance with drain plug law
- 97.81% compliance with all other AIS laws
- 1.37 inspections per hour (County-wide average)


#### Boat traffic comparable to 2022

- Many launches were subjected to low water levels. Impacted boat access.
- Gas prices remain high similar to 2022 prices.
- Inspections per hour up slightly from 2022
- One program goal is to get inspections/hour to pre-covid levels
  - (requires boat activity of course)
- More inspections/hour = More "bang for our bucks".

### A Few Close Calls...

- Multiple instances of denied launches
  - May 27<sup>th</sup>, Big Mantrap: Fishing boat
    - Weeds that couldn't be removed by hand
  - July 1<sup>st</sup>, Lake Belle Taine: Pontoon
    - Zebra Mussels attached to the pontoons
  - July 8<sup>th</sup>, Garfield Lake: Pontoon
    - Zebra Mussels attached to the pontoons
  - July 29<sup>th</sup>, Plantagenet: Fishing boat
    - Zebra Mussels found attached to vegetation on trailer
  - September 7<sup>th</sup>, Long Lake: Pontoon
    - Zebra Mussels found on sea-legs





### **Decontamination Summary**

- Staffed May 13<sup>th</sup> through September 25<sup>th</sup>
  - On-call 7 days a week: 10 AM 6 PM
- Renewed emphasis with updated decontamination-specific radio ads
- Early Season phone fiasco
  - Issues with Verizon/Track Phone reactivation.
  - Needed to change number
- 144 decontaminations performed despite early issues.
  - Up from 83 last year!





## 2023 AIS Infested Waters Updates

- Hubbard County concerns:
  - Zebra Mussels confirmed in Plantagenet
    - A single mussel was found in the autumn of 2022.
    - A flurry of reported sighting by anglers immediately after fishing opener.
    - DNR confirmed multiple populations June 29<sup>th</sup>.
  - Starry Stonewort confirmed at the Long Lake south access.
    - Discovered in early August by an aquatic plant survey hired by the lake association.
    - Small patch aggressive chemical treatment followed by a hand-pull.
    - No other patches were discovered in follow-up dives.

## 2023 AIS Infested Waters Updates

- In the neighborhood: Quieter than 2022...
  - Beltrami County:
    - Blackduck: Starry Stonewort
    - North Twin: Starry Stonewort

## 2024 Planning: Goals and Objectives

- Increase the number of decontaminations
  - Continue decon-specific radio advertisements increase public awareness
- Increase the number of inspections per hour
  - Continue designing inspection schedules with water-usage trends in mind
- Starry Trek 2023
  - Sample lakes getting increased boat traffic from SSW lakes
- Continue the Weedstick pilot program
  - Provide & promote weedsticks for public use throughout the county.
  - Find unique ways to better encourage their useage.
- Continue to reach out to resorts with specific, resort-tailored messaging

## 2024 Funding: Items to note

- 2024 AIS State Prevention Aid
  - \$263,911 (\$262,672 in 2023)
- Lake Association/Township Supplemental Funding
  - New inspector wages for 2023 were largely successful.
    - 42 total inspectors trained, 35 retained through mid-September (83%)
  - \$25/hour 2023 inspection rate is expected to remain.
  - Contract negotiations are underway with Always There Staffing.
- 2024 Payment Deadline: January 31st, 2024
  - ~7,200 State funded hours expected (similar to 2023)
  - Supplemental funding letters will go out early November.
