COVID-19 Related Program Changes

- DNR Level 1 inspector training set for April 18, 2020 Cancelled
- DNR Level 1 online training announced on April 30, 2020
- Began season on fishing opener with limited inspection staffing (23 lakes) due to the training delays.
- DNR Level 2 online training (returning inspectors only) announced on May 15, 2020
 - Only two returning Level 2 inspectors not enough to staff decon station
- County Board made decision for departments to limit expenses by 20%
 - Altered inspection hour totals from 15,744 to 13,200
- County Board authorized decon station to open June 28, 2020
- Level 2 online training for all inspectors announced July 21, 2020


Community Outreach Highlights

- 44 Level 1 Inspectors, 5 Level 2 Inspectors
- AIS prevention advertisements on KDKK,KXKK, KPRM
 - Decontamination, 21 day dry time, other AIS BMPs
- Movie theatre ad at the Park Theatre (COLA partnership) limited due to COVID-19
- AIS billboard US 71 south of Park Rapids (COLA partnership)
- Starry Trek searched 10 accesses on 9 lakes in Nevis area


Inspection Summary 2020


- Schedule just ended
- 13,200 hours worked
- Roughly 25,000 inspections
 - Currently completing survey data analysis
- 99.02% compliant with drain plug law
- 96.86% compliant with all other AIS laws
- 1.90 inspections per hour county wide average






Hubbard County AIS Inspections








Decontamination Summary

- Located near the entrance of Hubbard County Transfer Station
- 2020 staffed June 28 through September
 - On-call 7 days a week: 10 AM 6 PM
- Delayed start due to COVID-19 related training delays
- 4 primary decon inspectors
- 98 decons closed for season 9/30/19
- No major issues or violations at decon in 2020



2020 AIS Infested Waters Updates

Confirmed

- Big Mantrap Eurasian watermilfoil
- Long Zebra mussels
- Boulder Faucet snail



Funding: Items to Note

- 2021 AIS Prevention Aid
 - \$263,681
- Lake Association Supplemental Funding
 - Remains at \$21/hr for 2021
 - 2021 Payment Deadline: January 31st, 2021
 - Roughly 8,500 State funded hours (similar to 2019)
 - Dependent on County Board budget decisions
 - Supplemental funding letters will go out in the next month
