"RESTORE THE SHORE"

JERRY KNOBLICH - PORTAGE LAKE

COLA, IN COOPERATION WITH THE SOIL, WATER & CONSERVATION DISTRICT (SWCD) IS MAKING PLANTS AVAILABLE TO MEMBER LAKE SHORE OWNERS IN AN EFFORT TO "RESTORE THE SHORE". STUDIES SHOW THAT RETURNING VEGETATION TO THE "BUFFER ZONE' (AN AREA ROUGHLY 25 TO 50 FEET FROM SHORELINE) IMPROVES THE LAKES' WATER QUALITY, HELPS PREVENT EROSIAN, ASSISTS IN LOWERING FLOOD INTENSITY AND **ENHANCES** WILDLIFE AND **FILTERS** FERTILIZERS AND OTHER POLLUTANTS FROM ENTERING THE LAKE.

IF AN INDIVIDUAL ORDERED TREES AND SHRUBS DIRECTLY FROM THE SWCD, THE MINIMUM ORDER WOULD BE 25 FOR EACH SPECIES. HOWEVER, THROUGH THIS PROGRAM A PERSON CAN ORDER A SMALL NUMBER (2 OR 4 OR WHATEVER) OF EACH SPECIES AND THUS PLANT A GREATER VARIETY OF TREES AND SHRUBS. KEEP IN MIND" THINK IN TERMS OF BIODIVERSITY!

OVER 6,000 SHRUBS AND TREES HAVE BEEN ORDERED AND PLANTED DURING THE PAST THREE YEARS IN HUBBARD COUNTY. NOW IS THE TIME TO START PLANNING FOR SPRING 2003. THE SHRUB/TREE ORDERS ARE DUE IN SEPTEMBER. COLA LAKE WATER TESTING

Most lake associations are completing at least three consecutive years of lake water analysis by RMB Environmental Laboratories. The participating associations have been taking five monthly water samples each year plus taking frequent Secchi disk readings. During the testing period we have been receiving monthly reports that tell us the general health of our lakes. The monthly report tells how much phosphorous and chlorophyll are in our lake water.

This fall we will hear reports that will summarize the results of the tests for each of the participating lakes. For most associations there should be no surprises - the water quality will probably show no or very little change during the test period. Some people may be disappointed that the results aren't more dramatic or that they just tell us that our lake's condition has been stable the past three years.

The results of the water testing is just a beginning. To understand our lakes we need to develop a lake profile - water quality is just a part of the picture. We will be hearing about developing a lake profile this fall. Darren Moe from the Hubbard County Soil and Water District office will be working with COLA and the lake associations to begin that next step. This will be a great opportunity to pinpoint areas of concern and develop a plan to protect your lake from problems associated with erosion and loss of aquatic vegetation.

GLOBAL WARMING

"OUR TOILET WON'T FLUSH"

As a former resort owner I can tell you that you didn't want to have one of your guests tell you, "Our toilet won't flush". As a cabin owner you don't want to hear this because it will be on the 4th of July when you have a cottage full of guests. While there are several causes of this problem - I would like to address one of them.

Like your car, a septic tanks needs some maintenance. Because we put them in the ground and cover them up we tend to forget them. But the truth is they need to be pumped dry. here is the why, how often and how:

Your septic tank has three layers in it. the top layer is scum that is light weight matter that floats on the middle layer, the liquid layer. the liquid layer is the water you have added and solids that have been digested by the bacteria and changed to liquid. This is the layer that goes out of the tank and into your drain field. The third layer is sludge that builds up in the bottom and is mostly matter that the bacteria can't change into liquid.

As you use your tank the scum layer gets thicker and could get below the baffle and out your tank into the drain field. This plugs up the drain field and it stops working. "Our toilet won't flush"

"How often to pump?" is not an easy question to answer. As a minimum it should be every three years. Depending on your system and how much use it gets you may want to pump more often. A test is to put a pine board in at the manhole and push it to the bottom. The sludge will leave a mark on your board. If this is 12-16 inches thik it is time to pump.

There is no question as to what is a good pumping job. The only question is finding a person who can do a good job! All pumping jobs are not equal. This is what a good pumping job will include: It must be done through the manhole in the center of the tank. This is not one of those easy to get at 4 inch white pipes you have to mow around. This is a cement lid that weighs 100 pounds or more and is big enough so the pumper can visually inspect the inside of the tank.

The visual inspection may show some deterioration of the baffles or tank. The tank should also be back flushed. Here, the pumper

will pump liquid into the tank to stir up the sludge layer so it can be pumped out.

An oil change costs\$20 but a new engine costs \$2,000. Aseptic tank pumping job will cost you about \$65 but a new drain field may cost thousands. Put it on your maintenance schedule because you don't want to hear, "THE TOILET WON'T FLUSH!"


